BELOW IS INFORMATION CONCERNING THE FALL 2015 SEMESTER

Summer semester starts the week of August 18 and goes through December 17.

The cost for your semester is stated on the tuition line in the enrollment section above. Class lessons (*3 or more students*) and semi-private lessons (*2 students*) are \$21 per class. Private lessons are \$26 per thirty minute session.

- *The entire amount is due the first lesson of the semester (week of January 5) and is non refundable. If payment is not met by the second week of the semester, a late fee of \$20 will be applied to the tuition total. If payment is not met by the third week of the semester, the student will not be permitted to continue classes/private lessons unless otherwise agreed upon between teacher and parent.*
- **There are no makeup lessons or refunds for missed lessons. If the instructor has to cancel a lesson, he/she will reschedule the lesson. If a student knows ahead of time that he/she is going to miss a lesson, it may be possible to join another class lesson for that week or later in the semester.**
- There will be no lessons on major holidays and during weeks of Church of the Resurrection church-wide events.
- The music academy will follow inclement weather cancellations for the Blue Valley school district.

A NOTE TO THE STUDENTS
